Enrollment Lottery Application Form for the 2022-2023 School Year

The parent or guardian is responsible for ensuring they receive an email stating that this enrollment application was received. As a secondary confirmation to you, the school will email or call each applicant within two business days of receipt. Please call the school if you don't hear from us within this timeframe.

Your child **must be 5 years of age by August 31, 2022** to be eligible for Kindergarten registration. If the number of applications for any grade level exceeds the number of openings, the JPTA lottery procedure will follow. Please visit our school website for our Enrollment and Lottery policy.
