MEMORANDUM

RE: **2017-2018 Final State Equalization Guarantee (SEG) Budget Adjustment Request**

Today, in accordance with Laws 2017, Chapter 135, the General Appropriation Act of 2017 and Laws 2018, Chapter 73, General Appropriation Act of 2018, the final unit value for 2017-2018 school year budgets was reset at \$4,115.60. Correspondingly, \$19,599,999.93 in additional SEG was distributed statewide, of which \$9,599,999.98 is being made available for special education funding. The enabling language required PED to distribute these funds *after* calculation of the June SEG monthly allotment and distribution. This is the reason the Operational Fund BAR deadline was extended to June 27th in contrast to prior years in which the deadline was June 1st. It also further underscores the need to adhere to PED deadlines for information submittal. **The purpose of this memorandum is to indicate that the Operational Fund BAR deadline has been extended through June 29th.**

The PED cannot and will not supplant local school board authority to approve BAR's. School districts and charter schools will need to coordinate with their local school board or governing council to obtain approval for an increase BAR. Whether that takes the form of an emergency meeting, or receiving tentative approval from the school board or governing council prior to a July meeting, it will be up to the local school districts and charter schools to operationalize this piece. It is our expectation and sincere hope that no School Board or Governing Council would fail to approve additional dollars for education, particularly additional funding for our state's special education students.

The PED was faced with a decision between distributing this additional funding and providing an abbreviated window to operationalize the BAR process, or failing to distribute the funding. The PED chose to distribute additional dollars to school districts and charter schools and address the abbreviated window via this memorandum. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused your local school board or governing council. The PED will also endeavor to work with our Legislative partners in the future to better communicate the impact such tight time frames for distribution has on local processes.
